We would like to take this time to introduce the EYFS team – Mrs Hall is the Class Teacher. Miss Bayley is the Teaching Assistant, Lunchtime Supervisor and Paediatric First Aider. Mrs Wright is the Class Teacher on a Friday.

As you may be aware, the children will be spending time each day learning outside and we would ask you to send your child to school dressed in an appropriate outdoor coat, the school fleece or shower-proof jacket are available to purchase, but are not one of our compulsory branded items. They will need P.E. jogging bottoms for colder weather. On Wednesdays your child will need to wear P.E. kit to school.

Please could you also provide spare underwear and a change of clothes to in case of 'accidents' which may occasionally happen as the children get used to using the school toilets. If you have a son, it would be useful if you could teach them how to use a urinal as the boys' toilets have 3 of them, and only one sit down toilet. It is very important that your child can independently get dressed and undressed and manage their own belongings. All items of clothing must be named please. **The wearing of jewellery is not permitted for safety reasons. Also for health and safety reasons, wearing shoes with flashing lights, even with an on / off switch is not permitted – if you have already purchased these, it may be possible to remove the batteries to make them compliant with school rules.**

At the end of their first week in school, the children will be bringing home a Class Library book. After a few weeks of school, your child will be bringing home phonics words and phrases, and an FFT Phonics login to enable them to access online phonics reading books and games with your support. Sharing story and non-fiction books from home with your child, is also vitally important in order to encourage a love of reading. Could you please spend some time together each day reading books and talking about the story, information and pictures, and asking questions about the characters, setting and what might happen next.

A Universal Free School meal is provided for all children every day. The school will also provide a piece of fruit each afternoon. Please send in a labelled water bottle for your child every day.

If you have any concerns about any aspect of your child's progress or welfare, please share them with us. We can be contacted over the phone after school, or by emailing the school office.

We are looking forward to working in partnership with you to achieve the best for your child.
